1) Presentation of the Tournament

a) Date

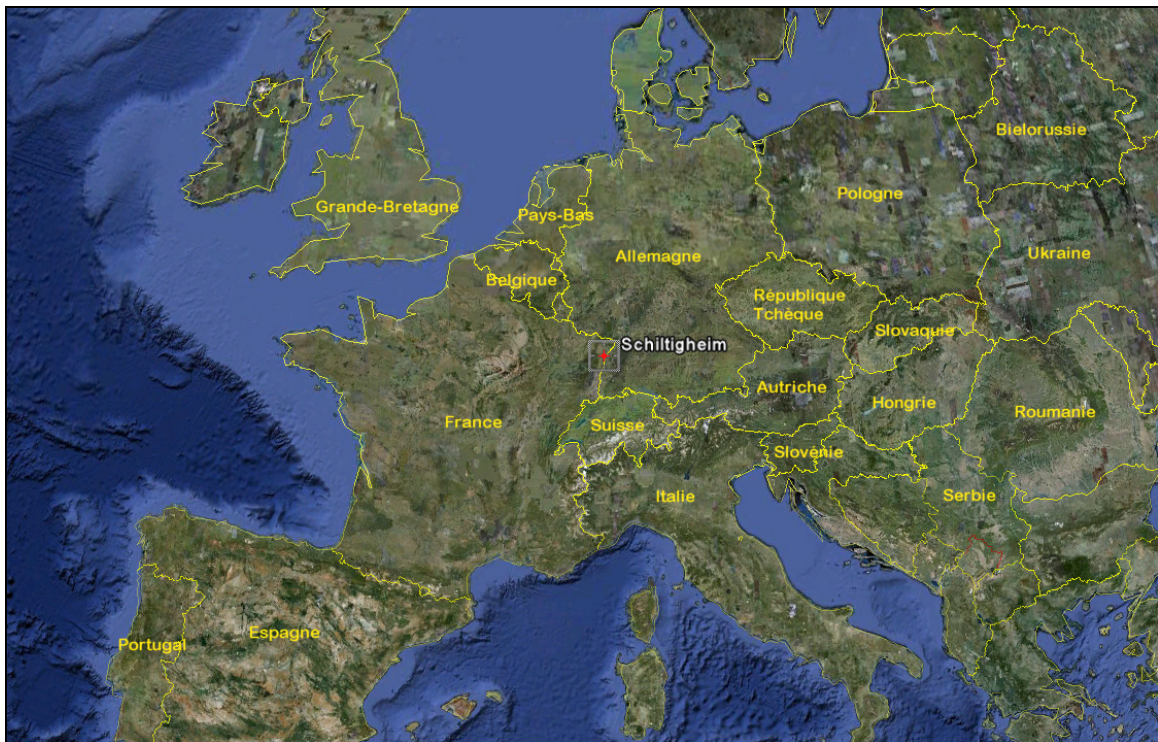
The tournament will take place **On Saturday, October 9th, 2010 at 4 pm**

b) Place

The meeting will take place in **Schiltigheim** :

Schiltigheim is a French municipality, situated in the department of the Bas-Rhin and the region Alsace. Situated in the conglomeration of Strasbourg, lining **Strasbourg** on all its north side, Schiltigheim is also the second city of the Bas-Rhin.

Strong of about 35,000 inhabitants, this city is famous for its breweries and is also endowed with a tremendous associative world.



c) Description of the facilities

The tournament will take place in :

**Gymnase des Malteries
49 rue des Malteries - 67300 SCHILTIGHEIM**

This gymnasium is about fifteen years old and is certainly one of the most beautiful from the east of France. Its architecture and original conception has it integrated into the city center, in front of the Heineken Brewery.



2) Technical Description of the Competition

a) General Rules

The competition joins in a format of type **Concours II : Individual Competition**.

The gymnasts will participate in every apparatus for the all around classification.

It will also be performed an apparatus classification (Competition III).

Gymnasts are required **to attend at least 4 apparatus**.

Will be invited to participate in this tournament : **36 gymnasts in MAG (max 48) and 24 in WAG (max 32)**

The competition will take place on a unique rotation, alternating rotation Male and Female on the Floor during the passages.

Additional Information :

- Apparatus of departure will be drawn one week before.

b) Schedule

- **Friday, October 8th, 2010**
Arrival of the gymnasts
2 pm - 8 pm : trainings
- **Saturday, October 9th, 2010**
9 am - 1 pm : trainings
2 pm - 4 pm : warm-ups

- 4 pm - 7 pm : Individual Concours
- 8 pm : Ceremony Dinner
- **Sunday, October 10th, 2010**
Departure of the gymnasts

It will be possible for certain gymnasts to arrive before Friday, October 8th. The trainings can be made on the site of the competition from Wednesday, October 6th or in other gymnasiums the previous week. For this option, get in touch with the organization committee.

c) Equipment

The set up equipment will be of the label 'Gymnova'.



a) Judgement

24 men judges and 16 women additional judges will be convened. Judges' bodies in every device will so consist of 4 members (2 JD + 2 JE). The distribution will take place some weeks before the tournament.

3) Accommodation-Catering

a) Accommodation

Gymnasts and officials will be accommodated first and foremost in superior-quality Hotels :

- Hôtel Le Forum ***
- Comfort Inn *** (New Hotel, opening in July)

b) Catering

The meals will be dispensed either in the restaurants of the places of accommodation, or in the room near the gymnasium.

The menus will be studied for sportsmen.

4) Financial Modalities

Gymnasts and Trainers will pay for the journeys round trip.

The organization committee will have at its expenses all the local transport during the duration of the tournament (see program).
